The Yacht

Miss Brizz is a custom built, 62 foot aluminum yacht. She boasts a beautiful teak interior and many of the amenitites you would find on much larger vessels - including a spacious salon with leather furniture, plasma TV, VCR, DVD, fully equiped galley with full size stainless steel appliances, three beautiful, guest staterooms, and captain and crew quarters. Miss Brizz is a dream come true for both sportfishermen and sightseers! The hull was designed with a sharp bow to cut the water, and a wide, 19 foot beam for a stable ride and spacious interior. She is powered by twin Lugger 6140's rated at 700 HP each and also has two 25KW Northern Lights Generators with sound shields - which allows quiet, yet lavish comfort on board. She boasts a full suite of electronics, including a SAT Phone and two of Simrad's latest fish finders. Miss Brizz also has an inflatable 14 ft. NAIAD with a Yamaha 25 HP 4 stroke engine for various shore excursions including beachcombing and hiking.




The exceptionally roomy back deck is over 320 square feet! Six electronic downriggers, a fishold with a seawater pump and drain, a fishcleaning station with hot and cold water, and a back deck closet filled with the finest fishing gear available, stand ready to meet all of your fishing needs. For those who are just looking to relax and enjoy the breathtaking views, a couch on the back deck is ready and waiting for you! An awning also extends out halfway over the back deck to keep you dry and comfortable should the weather turn a little inclement. For shore excursions and other adventures, there are large stairs off the back deck to allow for easy and safe access on and off the boat.



Fishing

If you are looking for the ultimate fishing trip, you will find it with Alaska Wilderness Voyages! Southcentral Alaska is renowned for some of the greatest fishing in the world! The incredible, nutrient-rich waters of the Gulf of Alaska flow into Prince William Sound, establishing a fertile habitat which supports a vast number of different species of fish. Here you can find world class fishing for trophy halibut, all five species of salmon, (King, Red, Silver, Pink and Chum), lingcod, the extraordinary salmon shark and several species of rockfish.

Imagine halibut so big they can only be referred to as "bardoors" or "shooters;" see salmon "dancing" across the pristine waters; battle the powerful salmon shark; feast upon some of the delicious lingcod and rockfish - all you have to do is step out on deck! Rates - 2025

Normally, we charter the vessel to one group of four to six guests, but we have, on occasion, combined smaller groups. We have priced our voyages two ways, premium and deluxe. All Voyages include: vessel, captain, crew, fuel, use of premium fishing tackle, bait, use of dinghy and basic amenities including bed linens and towels. We also vacuum pack and freeze your fish for you and provide one fish box per person. Voyages do NOT include: Fishing license, transportation to/from vessel, alcoholic beverages and gratuities. Tips for your captain and crew are customary and greatly appreciated. Minimum trip is four days and three nights. When you book a voyage, the boat is available to you at 8:00 AM the morning of your departure day. The vessel has a targeted return time your last day of 5:00 PM.

Premium Voyage - Meals and beverages are prepared and provided for you.

Six Guests \$8,250/day \$1,375 per person/day Five Guests \$8.000/day \$1,600 per person/day Four Guests \$7,800/day \$1,950 per person/day

Due to increasing fuel costs, it has been necessary for us to add a \$200.00/day fuel surcharge. If the cost of marine diesel exceeds \$3.50 /gallon, we reserve the right to add an additional surcharge.

Shark Hunts - There is an additional fee for shark hunts. Please call us at 907-345-9353 to obtain prices.
